Access our online services for charities

My Business Account (MyBA) is a fast, secure and easy way for organizations to access and update their Canada Revenue Agency (CRA) account information.

Using <u>MyBA (My Business Account)</u> for charities, you can complete these tasks online:

- Apply online to become a registered charity or a registered Canadian amateur athletic association.
- Submit a complete T3010 annual information return and required documentation, such as financial statements.
- Update information about your organization, upload supporting documents, and correspond with the Charities Directorate.

To use online services for charities through <u>MyBA (My Business Account)</u>, your organization needs a business number (BN) and an associated charity account (RR). To start, follow these steps:

Steps to access My Business Account for charities

Does your organization already have a business number and a charity account with the <u>CRA (Canada</u> <u>Revenue Agency)</u>?

Many organizations applying for charitable registration already have a <u>BN (business number)</u> and an associated RR account with the <u>CRA (Canada Revenue Agency)</u>.

Consider the following before requesting a new <u>BN (business</u> number) and RR account:

- Is your organization already registered?
- Is your organization incorporated under federal, provincial, or territorial statutes?
- Is your organization an internal division under a head body?

► Has your organization submitted an application to be a registered charity in the past?

► Is your organization trying to access <u>MyBA (My Business</u> <u>Account</u>) after having its charitable status revoked?

If you answer **no** to all the questions above, proceed to the next step.

) Get your business number and charity account

Business Registration Online is a one-stop, online, self-serve application that lets you register for the following:

- a <u>BN (business number)</u> (example: 123456789)
- an associated RR account (example: 123456789 RR 0001)

After you get a <u>BN (business number)</u> and an associated RR account, your organization can start using online services for charities through <u>MyBA (My Business Account)</u>.

Sign in to Business Registration Online

After you are signed in to Business Registration Online, choose one of the following options:

My organization has a <u>BN (business number)</u> and needs an associated RR account

▶ My organization needs both a <u>BN (business number)</u> and an RR account

A <u>BN (business number)</u> and RR account do not automatically make your organization a registered charity

To become one, you will still need to submit an application to <u>register a charity under the Income Tax Act</u>.

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Important: Are you trying to access <u>MyBA (My</u> <u>Business Account)</u> for a registered charity that is an internal division?

1. Contact your head body to confirm that it has a <u>BN</u>

(business number) and an associated RR account for your internal division.

 If your head body doesn't have them, it can obtain them by following the instructions in <u>step 2 – Get</u> Access our online services for charities - Canada.ca

- 2. <u>Register for Represent a client</u> to get a repID.
- 3. Your head body can then authorize you under their <u>BN</u> (business number) and your RR account.

Don't see your organization's <u>BN (business number)</u> in <u>MyBA (My Business Account)</u>?

If you don't see your organization's <u>BN (business number)</u> after you signed in to <u>MyBA (My Business Account)</u>, and you can't add it to your profile, call the Charities Directorate at 1-800-267-2384. We will need your social insurance number to link your identity to your organization's account.
